

## At5 - Workshop for PTSTA and CTA-Trainer

« A frame to experiment »

### ➡ Objectives

These workshops are a support space where people can get answers to their various questions: a space to step back on professional practice, to make sense of what is being done, to change habits, experiment and innovate; a solutions-seeker oriented space where it is as important to work on the process as on the content.

The PTSTA or CTA-Trainer is invited to argue on his practice, to make assumptions and to make intervention choices with reference to its conceptual foundations, in order to consolidate his practice and also to prepare for the TSTA exam.

### ➡ Program

Presentations and theoretical discussions - Development of teaching style  
Supervisions and Cascade Supervisions - Development of supervisor style  
Ethical case studies - Development of one's personal position

Mock examination to prepare the TSTA exam

Supervisors will therefore neither impose their views nor provide answers to people but instead rely on the PTSTA or CTA-Trainer resources. They are invited to develop their critical thinking and personal thought.

Work in these workshops takes place through a Contract that specifies the application, the expected outcome and the means to succeed: hence, everyone is involved.

### ➡ Participants

**PTSTA** Everyone who is a PTSTA or CTA-Trainer wishing to develop their skills of using Transactional Analysis in their PTSTA or CTA-Trainer professional activity. It is also suitable for those who are preparing to become TSTA

### ➡ Teaching Methods

Each workshop is organized into different and successive "timeframes":

- 1/2 day : with the CTA participation
- 1/2 day : with the participation of "under CTA Contract" people
- 1 day : only with the presence of PTSTA or CTA-Trainer (1 day)

Several teaching methods are proposed allowing to grow in several ways and this, at different times.

Participants can:

- bring to each workshop situations they want to monitor involving one of their own difficulties.
- supervise people "under CTA contract" and / or "CTA".
- experience Cascade Supervisions.
- discuss their supervision and teaching philosophy, or ask questions regarding their future exam
- present and discuss theory, ethics, TA organisations ...
